

MEETING OF THE CIVIL SERVICE COMMISSIONERS
FRANKLIN COUNTY
CONNELL, WASHINGTON
SEPTEMBER 22, 2017

The meeting of the Civil Service of the City of Connell was called to order at 9:31 a.m.

ROLL CALL

Present: Chair Regina Janosky, Commissioner Don Krein, Commissioner Ken Sellereite

Staff: Chief of Police Chris Turner, Secretary/Chief Examiner Onna Pollock

BUSINESS

Commissioner Krein made a motion to approve the minutes from June 20, 2017. Commissioner Sellereite seconded the motion. The minutes stand as read.

UPDATE FROM THE CHIEF

The Sergeants Promotional Exam was held last week with the Written Exam being on September 13th and the Oral Board on September 14th. In order to move on to the Oral Boards, the written exam had to be passed with a 70%. The Oral Board also had to be passed with a 70%. Approximately one month prior to the exam, Chief Turner sent an email to the officers requesting letters of interest for the open Sergeants position. Officer Kory Robertson was the only officer who submitted a letter of interest. Officer Robertson passed the written exam with an 82.5%.

On September 14, 2017, Officer Robertson went before the oral board. The board consisted of Trooper Marty Finan (Washington State Patrol), Sergeant Monty Huber (Franklin County Sheriff's Office) and Director Larry Turner (City of Connell). Officer Robertson's score for the Oral Board was 73.22%. Officer Robertson's overall score for both the written and oral exam was 77.86%.

Chief Turner explained a little about the position of Sergeant and that the primary role is to lead, guide and train the officers.

Chief Turner found that the Police Department budget is currently for the Chief of Police, one Sergeant and five officers. He will be going before the City Council on October 2nd with a resolution to change this to two Sergeants and four officers. Officer Robertson should be able to begin his role as Sergeant beginning October 16th.
