

**CITY OF CONNELL
PARK BOARD MEETING
May 30, 2018
Minutes**

Call to Order: 6:00 pm

Attendance:

Present: Chairman Manny Choi, Board Members; Betsy Aleman, and Sarah Gallo.

Staff: City Administrator Maria Peña, Secretary Marissa Ortiz, Pool Manager Jason Janosky.

Absent: Co-Chair Lilly McBride and Julie Brown.

Approval of Minutes:

Motion: Chairman Choi moved to approve the April 24th 2018 minutes as presented. Motion seconded by Board member Aleman. Motion passed unanimously.

ACTION & DISCUSSION ITEMS

Swimming Pool Update

Pool Manager Jason Janosky discussed the scheduled swimming pool opening. He stated 7 total lifeguards would return. Out of those 7, 2 were WSI certified. Instructor Dorothy Krein was also certified which would allow the city to offer swimming lessons this pool season. The 1st initial swim test was given to 5 of the lifeguards and all had passed. A few items at the pool house would need to be repaired by the Public Works department before the opening date. City Administrator Maria Peña pointed out that the Pool house had a fresh new coat of paint.

A tentative schedule for pool season 2018 was as follows:

Pool open for approximately 11 weeks, June 7-August 18

Open swim-1st session: 1-3 pm/2nd session: 5:30-7:30 pm and Swim lessons: 3:30- 5 pm

Three sessions of swim lessons: 1st- June 25- July 6, 2nd-July 16- July 23, 3rd-July 30- August 9

Previously the Park Board had recommended decreasing the total number of allowed users per family pass from 7 to 5. This change was presented to Council for approval. Council agreed but also wanted to see an additional charge per additional immediate family member after 5. City Administrator Peña asked board members to decide on a price. The recommendation was to charge \$10 to each additional family member. A new resolution with the new price would be presented to Council on June 4, 2018.

Other

City Administrator Maria Peña reported that she was approached by the Swim Team regarding selling concessions at the pool. The Swim Team would handle it all and the funds raised would go towards the Swim Team. City Administrator Peña and board members did not see an issue with them doing that and agreed.
