

MEETING OF THE CITY OF CONNELL, WASHINGTON  
CONNELL, FRANKLIN COUNTY, WASHINGTON

July 18, 2016

The regular semi-monthly meeting, of the Connell City Council was called to order by Mayor Blackwell at 6:00 pm in the City Hall and was opened with the Pledge of Allegiance.

ROLL CALL

CORRESPONDENCE/PRESENTATIONS/APPOINTMENTS

Franklin County Planning and Building department informed the city of a notice of Public Hearing for a preliminary Plat Subdivision.

Fire Chief Schulte thanked the Connell Police department for assistance on fires that were responded to by Franklin County Fire District #1 and the City of Connell fire department.

ORDER OF BUSINESS

LED STREET LIGHTING PROJECT

Bryan Taylor from Consolidated Electrical Distributor provided a downtown street lighting energy upgrade presentation to Council. The presentation reviewed current lighting in the City of Connell and new lighting that would improve lighting levels, increase energy saving and have lower maintenance. Cost estimates for the upgrade were given to councilmember's. Public Works Director Larry Turner would like to apply for a Transportation Improvement Board (TIB) grant to update city street lighting. Council's consensus was to move forward with the application to TIB for LED street lighting.

TOWN HALL MEETINGS-CANCELLED

Mayor Blackwell had promised if he was elected Mayor, he would hold Town Hall meetings each month. Now after several years of holding these meetings, the Mayor has decided to cancel the Town Hall Meetings due to lack of interest. These meetings were designed to create a forum to work on problems that involve citizens participation, which never came to fruit. Therefore, lack of citizen participation makes the Town Hall Meeting moot and useless. Council held discussion and would like Mayor Blackwell to continue holding the Town Hall meetings each month.

2016 BUDGET MID-YEAR REPORT

City Clerk/Treasurer Maria Peña reviewed the 2016 Budget revenues and expenditures through June 2016. Overall the City's budget was at 48% of revenues and 45.2% expenditures. The City was right on track with the 2016 budget adopted at the mid-year point.

City Clerk/Treasurer Maria Peña provided councilmember's and department heads with the 2017 Budget timeline of required budget dates.

Councilmember Quinton seconded motion. Motion carried unanimously.

**Motion:** Mayor Pro Tem Huber moved to extend the closing date of the purchase and sale agreement between SECTAD Investments and the City of Connell, with a requirement of 10% non refundable earnest money to be received within 3 business days. Councilmember Escalera seconded motion. Motion carried unanimously.
