

MEETING OF THE CITY OF CONNELL, WASHINGTON
CONNELL, FRANKLIN COUNTY, WASHINGTON

August 15, 2016

The regular semi-monthly meeting, of the Connell City Council was called to order by Mayor Blackwell at 6:00 pm in the City Hall and was opened with the Pledge of Allegiance.

CORRESPONDENCE/PRESENTATIONS/APPOINTMENTS

Franklin Co. Emergency Management donated the city an Onan 20Kw generator in fair condition; Mayor Blackwell thanked Fire Chief Schulte.

Numerous Plat Hearings for Franklin County were posted on the City Hall Bulletin Board.

Mayor Blackwell re-appointed Jeaniffer Ang Kaiser and appointed Lilly Johnson to The Park Board.

Motion: Councilmember Quinton moved to approve the reappointment for Jeaniffer Ang Kaiser and the appointment for Lilly Johnson to The Park Board. Councilmember Escalera seconded motion. Motion carried unanimously.

APPROVAL OF AGENDA

Motion: Councilmember Quinton moved to approve the agenda with change of the removal of #8 Closed Record Hearing revisions to CMC Title 8 Animals & Title 17 Zoning. Councilmember Silva seconded motion. Motion carried unanimously.

ORDER OF BUSINESS

BUDGET 101 CLASS

City Clerk Treasurer Rose Courneya briefed the council with an upcoming informational Budget 101 Class, presented by City Administrator Maria Peña at the next Town Hall Meeting September 12, 2016. City Administrator Peña would discuss the budget process for Connell and answer questions.

WATER SYSTEM PLAN (WSP) APPROVAL

Public Works Director Larry Turner presented council with the Water System Plan. Department of Health had already reviewed and gone through the draft and would now need Council's approval. Upon council's approval, he would forward an official letter to DOH.

Motion: Councilmember Minor moved to approve the Water System Plan. Mayor Pro Tem Huber seconded motion. Motion carried unanimously.

COMMITTEE / DEPARTMENT REPORTS

PUBLIC WORKS- Larry Turner

- 1) Corridor Inspector notified Public Works crew on a few spots on the Esquatzel that needed work and crews were dealing with repairs to prevent erosions and water breaks.
- 2) Well houses have been maintained.

POLICE DEPARTMENT – Police Chief Chris Turner

- 1) Looking forward for school to start, kids causing issues: lighting up fireworks, throwing rocks at buildings Friday and Saturday nights.

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- 2) Gearing up for Fall Festival.
- 3) Emergency driver's vehicle trainings later in the month for all officers.
- 4) Mayor Blackwell suggested to Chief Turner to consider a yearly talk on train safety at the School District.

FIRE CHIEF- Chris Schulte

Conducted the first live fire exercise with the camera on the ladder truck, still an experiment in progress. Will keep council informed once he figured out how to make it work.

CITIZEN COMMENT/NON-AGENDA ITEMS

Fall Festival Helen Tobin -

Spoke on Fall Festival, ready and lined up for 2016. This year the public was able to download vendor and registration forms from Fall Festival website. Appreciated Ed Brown and Public Works for hanging up the banner across Columbia Avenue and all the work they provided for Fall Festival Committee. She also acknowledged the support of the city.

Jerry Sackmann-

Voiced he had collected twenty-seven signatures from kids that would like a Soccer League within the city. Pastor Sam from New Life Church also had an additional twenty signatures. Mr. Sackmann asked if the City would help these forty-seven kids with forming an after school Soccer League. He knew parents and coaches who would volunteer. He pointed out that businesses within the city could help sponsor.

Regina Grassl-

Concerned with the city pool and next year's budget.

Helen Tobin-

Reminded city council that new City Administrator Maria Peña needed goals and expectations and they needed to give her direction. She hoped that everyone was on the same page.
